

19 Stationary hydration reminder

What does it do?



Stationary hydration reminders can be placed on a glass or mug to monitor the drink frequency of the user. Built-in tilt sensors monitor how often the user has taken a drink and the device prompts the user to have a drink if the measured drink frequency is too low. Prompts can be recorded but there are also pre-set notification options. The prompts can also be set to specified intervals.

What can it be used for?

#Reminder Stationary hydration reminders can remind PwD to drink regularly to prevent dehydration.
